Purpose: The purpose of this Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) is to describe the

procedures surrounding pilot studies.

1. Introduction and Definitions: Both the CCAC and the UACC encourage the use of pilot studies when new approaches, methods or products are being tried, before approving new, large-scale protocols.

Pilot studies are defined as AUPs where the outcome of what is being proposed is generally unknown. This could include the determination of a half-to define statistical variability which will enabl warranted. The results of the study should also well as the experimental endpoints for any fut
