

Graduate Student Opportunity in Fish Ecotoxicology

Project Description

An international team of ecotoxicologists, chemists, and engineers have come together to better understand the effects of pipeline oil spills in Canada's west coast rivers on Chinook salmon (*Oncorhynchus tshawytscha*). This ambitious research program involves simulating spills of diluted bitumen in outdoor experimental rivers at the [Quesnel River Research Center](https://www.qe3research.ca/roq-research-center/) in British Columbia. This study will answer whether residual oil trapped in salmon rearing habitats impairs the health and survival of Chinook embryos. Learn more about the project:
