In accordance with sub. 9(d) of the Senate Policy on Student Appeals, Rights and Discipline, if a student does not appeal a decision of the AMS or the SGPS Judicial Committee in which the sanction is a recommendation that a student be required to withdraw from the University, that sanction shall take effect only after it has been approved by the Senate Committee on NonAcademic Discipline (SONAD).

During the academic session September 1, 2010 to August 31, 2011, no such recommendation was submitted to SONAD for review and approval.
