Does the university consider them to be instructors? If so, which policies apply to them? If not, what is their status? As it stands, regulations and policies regarding teaching assistants at Queen's University are formulated by the TA Consultative Committee. What committees or decision making bodies perform this function for teaching fellows? Who represents them?
