Principal's Written Report Queen's University Senate 22nd May, 2012

In my report this month I would like to draw Senate's attention to some of the events that I haveattendedor will attend both on campus and off campus. Although these are listed among the schedule highlights appended to this report, I miention just three of them in more detail.

Threeweeks ago I participated in judging for the inaugural Queen's 3 mirthtesis competition. This initiative, launched by the School of Graduate Studies, encourages each graduate student competitor to explain their thesis without props and in terms understandable to the general public, in no more than three minutes. Along WiP Research Steven Liss, United Way Kingston President Bhavana Varma, and former Speaker of the House of Commons Peter Milliken, I was delighted to participate and hear these emerging researchers provide succinct and engaging summaries of their theses in a readily understandable fashion. The winner, Jennifer Campbell, a doctoral candidate in Engineering Physics, spoke with lucidity about "Nanocantilevers: a new tool for medical diagnos" tiesed drew the audience in with a reference to her childhood fear of injections. This research that spans engineering, physics and health sciences is a wonderful example of the power of interdisciplinarity.

The Town Gown Association of Ontario held its annual symposium in Kingston this year with the theme Cities for People: Creative Town and Gown Communities opening reception in the Agnes Etherington Art Centre provided an opportunity to showcase this premier university art gallery to representatives from university towns across the province. I was able towibleak the Minister of Training Colleges and Universities, Glen Murray, about the important role that we play in the community and region and to provide examples of how we can increase universitycity engagement to the benefit of all.

On May 1th, I willparticipate in a oneday conference which will splore new ideas to create healthy campuses to support students with meriteral than challenges. The conference, 'Focus on Mental Health', is sponsored by COU and Colleges Ontario along with the College Stude Alliance and the Ontario Undergraduate Student Alliance.
