APTF Progress to date

In our first meeting (September 27), the APTF established a working plan for addressing the issues assigned to the committee by the 2010-11 APTF. We identified **first quri**ority Issue 1: Virtualization and Online Leaing, and devised a structure to identify the issues that concern the academic community. We will consider **Issu** Faculty Renewal after making sufficient progress on our first priority, likely beginning with our December meeting.

We have identified three themes within the spe of online learning nabling subsets of the committee to focus in on more specific issues between monthly meetings of the APTF.

Theme 2. Assessing and Recommending Qualitytrol Mechanisms for Online Courses (Moyes, Atkinson, Swartz)

Theme 3. Identifying Problems and Solutions Conallenges with Technology and Support (*Moyes, Elliott, Bridges*)

A major priority in this work is to engagine community in identifying strengths and weaknesses in current practices in online learn Tings will involve meetings between identified stakeholders and the APTF committee, as wellt is ation of the online forums to sample opinion more broadly. Each month, beginning will move 1, we will post a new question on the interactive web forum acseible from our website (http://www.queensu.ca/s)ap will anticipate submitting a preliminary report in March, solution of the report is to be submitted for the May Senate meeting.
