1. Question regarding the inappropriate use of emergency phones on campus.

What does the University intend to do to discourage students from participating in the "blue light challenge," which violates the spirit of the Queen's community and might put people at risk?

Background: (provided by *Anne-Marie Grondin*, Executive Assistant, Society of Graduate & Professional Students (SGPS))

There are currently 176 indoor and outdoor phones. Approximately 75 of these are placed outside, and are equipped with blue lights. Only a few lights are CCTV-operational: those in Tindall and ARC parking lots. Thus, campus response relies heavily on audio communication. All calls from emergency phones receive the high
